Vehicle Acquisition Discounts

Did you know that the Broader Public Service (BPS) has access to the province's vehicle pricing discounts?

It's as simple as adding one sentence to your tender document.

The province has a Vendor Of Record (VOR) agreement for the supply and delivery of passenger, light commercial and enforcement vehicles to fill Ontario Public Service (OPS) vehicle requirements.

The Agreement may be used, on a voluntary basis, by operational agencies and crown corporations of the Ontario Government and by **Broader Public Sector (BPS) organizations including municipalities, schools and hospitals.**

The current VOR agreement includes contracts with:

- Chrysler Canada
- Ford Canada
- General Motors of Canada
- Mercedes-Benz Canada (Smart and Sprinter)
- Nissan Canada

Arrangements have been made with the above listed manufacturers to extend the province's concession dollars to the BPS. In order to maintain audit ability of the BPS tender process, all you have to do is add one line to your tender.

Add:

"(BPS -- your official name) is part of the Broader Public Service of the Province of Ontario and as such is entitled to the concessions (discounts) as arranged by the Ministry of Government Services under VOR: OSS 074423."

The dealer who has picked up the tender knows to price the vehicle as per your specifications and to contact their respective National Fleet office who will supply the appropriate concession.
