## NFPA 1006 Passenger Vehicle Extrication

This course will present vehicle extrication theories, techniques, & challenges that involve common passenger vehicles, to accurately & safely execute the skill sets required for professional certification. Topics include rescue incident management, extrication strategies & tactics for common passenger vehicles, resource management, stabilization systems, hazard identification & control, extrication tools, methods, & selection criteria, basic patient care, packaging, & lifting & moving, and basic extrication techniques.

Provincial testing through AS&E with the Office of the Fire Marshal will be conducted at the conclusion of the in-class sessions. To receive certification, students must also complete and submit their skills sign-off sheets to AS&E
