 different communities in order to address the "dried up wells" and to increase diversity of
 staff to better reflect the communities we serve.

- Jeremy Inglis mentioned Winnipeg Fire and Emergency Services' Diversity and Equity Fire Training Program and the idea of a "community day" (Central-York).
- Melissa Gennaro looking for DEIB recognition program award criteria.
- Annex Business' Security I Police I Fire Career Expo (Jeremy Inglis): fire services are underrepresented at this expo. Departments are encouraged to participate in upcoming expos. Great/motivated candidates.
- OAFC DEI Funding (Jeremy Inglis): Parkin/Inglis working on two funding streams to be made available to fund DEI initiatives; members/initiatives to fund initiatives in their communities (e.g., grants), and monetary grants to individuals entering the fire service. These funds are being made available through OAFC annuities.
- OAFI self-disclosed demographic data is now available. Departments who use OAFI can request data through Mark MacDonald.
