SUBJECT: 2026/27 Mental Health Supports for Public Safety Personnel Grant Program – The call for applications will open on June 9, 2026

The call for applications is now open for the 2026/27 Mental Health Supports for Public Safety Personnel (MHS4PSP) grant program to eligible public safety organizations in the fire sector.

The MHS4PSP grant program provides funding to support the purchase of mental health services that have been designed for public safety personnel, as offered through Warrior Health.

Warrior Health has partnered with leading mental health care providers – including Wounded Warriors Canada, Homewood Health, the Centre for Addiction and Mental Health, Trillium Health Partners, and Boots on the Ground – to improve access to more than 150 fee-for-service programs.

In 2025/26, the MHS4PSP grant program supported approximately 73 fire services with funding for the purchase of trauma-informed mental health services, such as general wellness programs and peer support training.

All municipal, regional, and First Nations public safety organizations in the fire sector are eligible for funding. To apply,

- Visit Transfer Payment Ontario (TPON)
- Review MHS4PSP grant program Guidelines on TPON
- Submit an Application Form on TPON between June 9, 2026 and July 7, 2026
- Email a completed copy of the submission to MH.Secretariat@ontario.ca.

*Please note that access to the call for applications in TPON will close as of 4:00 PM Eastern Daylight Time on July 7, 2026.
